County judge gets GOP nod for re-election

Dutchess County Court Judge Peter M. Forman has been endorsed for re-election by the county Republican Committee, Forman said recently.

Forman, first elected a Family Court judge in 1999, announced his bid for re-election last month. He was nominated by the Dutchess Republicans at a May 25 convention.

Forman is president-elect of the Dutchess County Bar Association, is a member of the Mid-Hudson Women's Bar Association and teaches Family Law at Marist College as an adjunct faculty member.

"It is a privilege to serve the residents of Dutchess County in the Family Court," Forman said in a prepared statement. "It is a very important court where difficult decisions must be made that affect the lives of children and their parents."
